Tournament Rules

- The Star City High School Open is sponsored by the Lincoln Bowling Association and is open to bowling teams of high school students in good academic standing and attending a high school (public or private) in the United States of America, that meet the following conditions;
 - Nebraska teams must be composed of students in accordance with the Nebraska High School Bowling Federation By-Laws (www.nshbf.com).
 - Non-Nebraska entries will be allowed in accordance with their respective states athletic association guidelines and regulations (HSBUSA recognized).
 - Any team that did NOT compete in their USBC recognized state high school bowling program the immediate season prior to the SCHSO, may only participate with a team of student-athletes comprised of one single school (no new "co-ops"). All state-approved combined (co-ops) school teams must request permission, in writing, from the tournament director prior to competition, or will be disqualified.
- The Star City High School Open is certified by the United States Bowling Congress. This event is governed by the USBC Youth Division. Students must present their USBC certification card AND acceptable form of student ID at the time of check-in or they will be required to pay the \$2 participation fee. Incomplete team/singles entry information will be rejected and returned. Only completed entry forms will be accepted. Teams withdrawing from the event within five days of the event start date will not receive a refund.
- Scholarships are underwritten by the Lincoln Bowling Association. Team entry fee due 03/12/12 MC/VISA/AmEx/Discover accepted.
- Team Event - there will be a separate boys and girls division with entries limited to 64 total teams. All competition will be scratch. A minimum of 4 teams of each type (boys or girls) are required to have a legal squad. Schools may enter multiple teams, in accordance with the eligibility rules. The top 50% of each squad will advance to the finals on Sunday. The tournament director may alter that percentage (up or down within 5%) to allow an appropriate number of teams to facilitate the finals, based on the number of entries in each squad. Only paid entries reserves a spot.
- Playing strength of teams shall be five bowlers, although a team's roster may carry up to seven players. No straw scores will be allowed. Each participant may enter only once.
- Two player substitutions are allowed at any time **during** a regular qualifying game or Baker game. Baker lineup and/or substitutions may be made **prior** to the start of any Baker game. Additional substitutions will only be allowed in the event of an injury and the permission of the tournament director.
- Players should be dressed with like shirts printed with the school name. Sweatpants, denim jeans, shorts, hats, and T-shirts with obscene or offensive material will not be allowed. *Teams are encouraged to wear like slacks or skirts. DENIM IS NOT ALLOWED!!!*
- Tournament Agenda:
 - Saturday - 10:00am Coaches Registration, 11:00am Coaches Meeting, 11:15am Opening Ceremonies
 - 11:20am Noon Squad practice, 11:30am squad begins qualifying, all boys and girls teams bowl 3 regular games then 3 Baker games.
 - 2:30pm Coaches Registration (4pm Squad), 3:30pm Coaches Meeting, 3:45pm Squad Announcements
 - 3:50pm 4pm Squad practice, 4pm squad begins qualifying, all boys and girls teams bowl 3 regular games then 3 Baker games.
 - Sunday - 8am double-elimination rounds begin (*best 3 of 5 Baker Matches)
- All players, coaches, and spectators are expected to behave in a positive manner. Abusive behavior and/or gestures will not be tolerated and may result in a player or team removed from the tournament. Only players, coaches and tournament officials will be allowed in the bowler's areas. Sun Valley Lanes is a smoke-free facility. There will be an admission charge of \$3/person. Admission does not guarantee a seat, only admission into the facility.
- A minimum of \$10,000 in college scholarships will be awarded between both events. Team scholarships awarded as follows; Boys 1st - \$2000, 2nd -\$1500, 3rd - \$1000, 4th - \$500. Girls 1st \$2000, 2nd -\$1500, 3rd - \$1000. There is no 4th place scholarship for the girls division. The high boys and girls individual series (during team qualifying) on each qualifying squad will receive a \$125 scholarship.
- Any rules not covered here will be settled in accordance with USBC rules. The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329. If during this event an act of God prevents its conclusion, the standings will be final as of the last completed round.
