# Sunday Showdown

## Rules of Play

The Sun Valley lanes 'House Shot' will be the pattern of choice.

SVL Management holds the right to alter the pattern at anytime without notice.

2010/2011 book average to be used.

If no 10-11 book average exists, you may use 11-12 average of 21 games or more, otherwise you will bowl scratch(220). Averages to be re-rated after 12 qualifying games. Tournament average will be based on tournament performance. Youth will use highest average, whether it be USBC or NHSBF of 12 games or more. Tournament official may re-rate any individual(s) deemed 'Sandbagging' at any time. Any player being re-rated will be notified day of tournament.

Prize Fund calculated based on number of participants for each sweeper.

Lineage will be \$7.00 per entry. Payout breaks down as follows:

40% 1st, 30% 2nd, 20% or free entry for 3rd\*, 10% or large one topping pizza(\$10 scholarship for youth player) for 4th\*.

High game pot will be paid out after each game (scratch total plus handicap).

The amount will vary depending on number of bowlers entering into High Game Pot. Youth are eligible for hi game and 300 jackpot as well as 1st through 4th prize money, but all money will be paid to there respective SMART Accounts on a Bi-monthly basis. \$.50 of each High Game Pot entry goes to the Progressive 300 Jackpot (300 scratch), the balance of \$4.50 goes to the High Game Pot and will be divided equally by 4, the awarded after each game of qualifying.

Any rules not covered above are governed by the USBC rules of play.

*SVL reserves the right to cancel this event at anytime due to scheduling conflicts with other events. All averages will be verified through Bowl.com This is a sanctioned monthly sweeper and all honor scores will be submitted for USBC approval.*
